- 2. Bonus: As they come down from the Transfiguration: Jesus' disciples are questioned on healing which only comes through prayer and fasting in Verse 29. Is this a coincidence?
- 3. Why do you think Listening to God could be the greatest gift we have to experience? How has this worked in your life before?
- 4. Why is it so hard to be silent before God?
- 5. How can we cultivate a continued shared presence with God?
- 6. Can we still sense God's presence when we are busy? Is it possible or just harder to do?
- 7. What does this verse tell you about the character of God? "But while he was still a long way off, his father saw him and was filled with compassion for him; he ran to his son, threw his arms around him and kissed him." Luke 15:20
- 8. What needs to change for you to spend silent contemplative time with God?
- 9. Renewed view of God? Renewed view of self? Change in schedule? What is stopping you?
