Easter 2021 Small Group Questions:

1. Read aloud Psalm 23 - What does this passage say about God's relationship to us?
2. Have you ever been in a place where you needed to be rescued in a very real way? What were the emotions you experienced? How did you feel before, during and after your rescue moment?
3. What feelings do you experience at the thought of someone offering to pay off all of your financial debt? We should treat our spiritual debt with even more seriousness, understanding the weight of our sin debt and the magnitude of what Jesus offers us.
4. Talk about the idea of "spiritual debt." What do you think this means and why is it so serious? Read aloud Romans 6:23
5. God's gift of salvation to us is not merely a "get out of hell free card," but is an invitation to a new way of life where we live in freedom because of God's grace. This allows us to live above sin with the guidance of our Shepherd. Reflect and share with your group about a hard season you've walked through. Where did you find strength in the midst of hard circumstances? What does it do for us in those seasons to know that God is our shepherd here on earth?
6. Reflect on the moment you opened your heart's door to Jesus for the first time & share with the group the significance of that moment or
7. If you have yet to say yes to Jesus, I would challenge you to consider the offer of God. What is holding you back from opening the door of your heart to Him?
