February 28th, 2021 Pastor Ed "From More Volunteers to More Masterpieces"

- 1. Read Ephesians 2. Like the previous lesson, pretend you've never experienced church and that what you read in Ephesians 2 is your first and only exposure to the characteristics of church. What conclusions or assumptions would you make about church?
- 2. Read Ephesians 2:10. Is this a promise for the church or for each individual believer?
- 3. What are the stewardship implications to each person being a masterpiece of God with a unique set of good deeds to accomplish?
- 4. What, in particular, about the passage convicted you personally about something in your life and leadership?
- 5. Is this a shift that is worth the effort to pursue and to see put in place? How important is it to you? Why or why not?
- 6. In five years from now, if you were mobilizing God's people, God's way with an approach that was rooted in "more masterpieces" rather than "more volunteers," what would that look like?
- 7. What would the characteristics of success be? What benefits? Create a list of characteristics that collectively describes a preferable future.
- 8. Are there actions you already know you'd need to take that can be identified now?
